MR T NICHOLLS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General provide an update of the total costs to date the State has incurred in legal costs on the Trad matter?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Department of Justice and Attorney-General that the proceedings in the Supreme Court involving Ms Trad were recently concluded by consent. The Crime and Corruption Commission (CCC) has been ordered to pay Ms Trad's costs of the proceedings. Ms Trad is required to reimburse the State for any costs recovered in the proceedings. The amount of costs to be recovered from the CCC is in the process of being determined, as such I am unable to provide an accurate account of the costs in this matter at present.
