QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of apprentices and trainees directly employed by the Department of Environment and Science as at 30 September 2023 (reported separately by vocational qualification)?

ANSWER:

There are no apprentices or trainees directly employed by the Department of Environment and Science as at 30 September 2023.
