QUESTION

With reference to the answer to Question on Notice No. 1119 of 2023— Will the Minister advise if the government has ruled out identifying and securing land for a new site for the Gympie Hospital?

ANSWER

I am advised that the Sunshine Coast Hospital and Health Service, with the support of Queensland Health, Clinical Planning and Service Strategy and Health Capital Division are progressing through the infrastructure assurance and approvals processes associated with the business case.

The business case for the Gympie Hospital includes the master planning and concept design phase which will consider the infrastructure requirements and most suitable siting based on the current and future service needs of the Gympie community.

The government will consider the options in the business case once it has been finalised.
