MR D LAST ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

With reference to the new Learning Centre at Moranbah East State School announced in 2021—

Will the Minister advise the revised total cost and completion date?

ANSWER:

In 2022–23, the Queensland Government is investing \$1.9 billion in state school infrastructure to build, maintain, improve and renew schools across Queensland. This investment provides for new and enhanced school facilities right across Queensland, ensuring the youngest Queenslanders can learn in quality education facilities.

In 2022–23, the Department of Education committed an investment of \$5.29 million to deliver a new learning centre at Moranbah East State School. The department is currently reviewing the construction methodology for this project and a cost estimate will be determined once the methodology has been clarified. The department will ensure the project meets the school's needs and provide a value-for-money outcome for taxpayers.

The new learning centre is due to be completed in 2024.
