MRS D FRECKLINGTON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND MANUFACTURING AND MINISTER FOR WATER (HON G BUTCHER)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister list the number of departmental employees as of March 2023 (reported separately by Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations code) and for each (a) the occupation code description, (b) whether it is a frontline, frontline support or corporate service role and (c) if the data for this role was provided to the Public Service Commission?

ANSWER:

The Public Sector Commission (PSC) is responsible for collecting and publishing the Minimum Obligatory Human Resource Information on behalf of the Queensland Government.

The Department of Regional Development, Manufacturing and Water (DRDMW) validates this information prior to it being provided to the PSC on a quarterly basis.

DRDMW adheres to the PSC procedure in supplying Minimum Obligatory Human Resource Information data. This data collection process requires human resource officers in DRDMW to manually code on appointment, every FTE position within their agency with an Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations code that best matches the duties of that position. As part of this manual coding process the human resource officers will also nominate whether the role undertakes frontline/frontline support or corporate service duties.

The data sets submitted by DRDMW are further validated by the PSC and if necessary, DRDMW will work with the PSC to clarify specific roles.
