**MR J LISTER** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier list the number of Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning employees as of September 2022 (reported separately by Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations code) and for each (a) the occupation code description and (b) whether it is a frontline, frontline support or corporate service role?

ANSWER:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) is responsible for collecting and publishing the Minimum Obligatory Human Resource Information (MOHRI) on behalf of the Queensland Government.

The Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning (DSDILGP) validates this information prior to it being provided to the PSC on a quarterly basis. The last quarter reported was current as at 31 December 2022 and was submitted to the PSC in January 2023.

DSDILGP adheres to the PSC procedure in supplying MOHRI. This data collection process requires DSDILGP to manually code every FTE position within the agency with an Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations code that best matches the duties of that position. As part of this manual coding process DSDILGP also nominates whether the role undertakes frontline and frontline support or corporate service duties.

Prior to publishing, the data sets submitted by DSDILGP are further validated by the PSC and, if necessary, DSDILGP will work with the PSC to clarify specific roles.
