DR M ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) if there have been any changes to the delivery of the maintenance program for departmental properties and (b) the number of properties currently untenanted across the Redland and Wynnum areas whilst awaiting repairs?

ANSWER:

There have been no changes to the delivery of the maintenance program for departmental properties.

As at 31 March 2023, there are eleven properties currently vacant and undergoing maintenance and repairs in the Redland Local Government Area and in the suburb of Wynnum. This is 0.6% of the total number of government managed properties in those areas.

As the property owner, the Queensland Government is responsible for maintaining public housing properties, so they are fit for purpose, in good repair and comply with statutory requirements. The department also manages a planned maintenance and upgrade program.
