MR D PURDIE ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the top three priorities on the School Strategic Infrastructure Plan (SSIP) for each of the state schools in the Ninderry Electorate?

ANSWER:

When considering new infrastructure projects for school facilities, the Department of Education works with principals to develop a list of priorities through a School Strategic Infrastructure Plan (SSIP). The SSIP is the department's primary method for identifying and prioritising important facility needs for each Queensland state school.

SSIP proposals are submitted for consideration and assessed through a prioritisation process to ensure the highest needs across the State are met. This process is used to develop the department's short, medium and long-term investment priorities, which are subject to funding approval.

SSIP data is used for internal purposes only and is subject to regular review and update. Therefore, schools are best placed to inform their local school communities of their priorities.
