MR S ANDREW asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier provide details (reported separately by year and reason for acquisition/resumption/extinguishment i.e. resource interests, private infrastructure facility, protected area estate etc) the number of times since 2017 (a) that property/land in Queensland has been compulsorily acquired or resumed by the government or any of its authorised entities, whether in whole or in part and (b) that Native Title land in Queensland has been either sold or surrendered to the Crown or extinguished by it, whether in whole or in part?

ANSWER:

- (a) The number of parcels of property/land compulsorily acquired by the Coordinator-General by year since 2017.

- (b) No Native Title rights have been compulsorily acquired by the Coordinator-General since 2017.
