QUESTION:

With reference to reported offences in the Burleigh Electorate— Will the Minister advise the number (a) total offences, (b) assault (grievous, serious, serious (other), common), (c) robbery (armed, unarmed), (d) offences against the person, (e) unlawful entry (with intent dwelling, without violence - dwelling, with violence - dwelling, with intent - shop, with intent other), (f) arson, (g) other property damage, (h) unlawful use of motor vehicle, (i) fraud (computer, cheque, credit card, identity, other), (j) offences against property, (k) drug offences and (l) traffic and related offences, for the periods 1 July 2022 to 14 April 2023?
