MR A POWELL ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to the government's 2020 election commitments—

Will the Minister provide an updated project budget, initial project completion date, and any revised project completion dates for the following project in the Wide Bay region, as outlined in the Progress report on 2020 government election commitments (September 2022) - '\$15m for a new adult alcohol and other drug residential rehabilitation and treatment facility in Bundaberg. The facility will include eight withdrawal beds and 20 rehabilitation beds'?

ANSWER

The Palaszczuk Government is committed to delivering world-class health care to all Queenslanders no matter where they live.

That's why in the leadup to the 2020 Election we committed to building three new alcohol and other drug facilities across Queensland.

I refer the Member to the project status update provided in QoN 249 tabled 27 April 2023.

I am advised that further information in relation to expected timeframes for practical completion and any changes to original budget estimates will be known following the award of the tender.
