MR T WATTS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the increase in Youth crime in Toowoomba—

Will the Attorney-General advise since 2020 (reported separately by year) how many youth offenders have been found guilty of committing one or more of the offences listed in (a) to (c) below and how many were sentenced to a period of incarceration (a) 'break and enters' (b) 'unlawful use of a motor vehicle' and (c) 'assaults'?

ANSWER:
