Question on Notice No. 505 Asked on 9 May 2023

Mr D Crisafulli asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise if the Premier or the Premier's office is aware of any acts of noncompliance with the Queensland Ministerial Handbook that have occurred within the last 12 months and, if so (a) the nature of the non-compliance, (b) the name(s) of individuals involved and (c) actions taken by the Premier due to this non-compliance?

ANSWER:

I am advised that the Office of the Premier has not received any briefing notes from the Department of the Premier and Cabinet regarding any allegations of noncompliance with the Queensland Ministerial Handbook within the last 12 months.

I am advised that meetings occur between the Premier's Office and the Department of the Premier and Cabinet regarding ministerial services matters, including the Ministerial Handbook which provides guidance to all Ministers, Assistant Ministers and staff on the operations of their offices.

I am further advised that any matters of alleged non-compliance with elements of the Ministerial Handbook are dealt with by the appropriate officer, administratively or through the appropriate avenue.
