QUESTION:

With reference to the former police superintendent Mark Ainsworth calling for the introduction of a diversion centre in remote Queensland for recidivist youth offenders—Will the Attorney-General advise if the government will reconsider its stance on relocation sentencing to make a remote diversion centre part of the response to addressing youth crime?

ANSWER:
