QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide a list of termite and pest inspections conducted in State Schools over the last five years, including the school name and the year/s termite and pest inspection were done?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education is committed to providing high-quality facilities to support effective teaching and learning in a safe environment. To achieve this, Queensland state schools are provided with school maintenance funding allocations to ensure that schools are maintained to an appropriate standard.

Termite and pest inspections carried out at Queensland state schools are managed locally at the school level. Maintenance funding allocations may be used to undertake these tasks.

As termite and pest inspections are not managed centrally, data is not recorded on a central register.
