MR J LISTER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

## QUESTION

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 434 of 2022— Will the Minister provide the percentage of Patient Off Stretcher Times (POST) achieved within 30 minutes for each hospital which collects POST data, as listed on the 'Queensland Reporting Hospitals' website (reported separately by calendar month)

## **ANSWER**

for October 2022 to January 2023?

Queensland's emergency departments are leading the nation. ROGS data for financial year 2021/22 shows that Queensland had the second best performing emergency department in the country with 68 per cent of patients seen within the recommended time, second only to New South Wales who saw 77 per cent of patients in within the recommended time.

The most recent quarterly performance data shows that Queensland has now surpassed New South Wales, with Queensland seeing 72% of patients in the recommended timeframes and New South Wales seeing 66.4% within the timeframes set out in ACEM's ATS tool.

I am advised by the department that Patient Off Stretcher Time (POST) is available for reporting on the 14th day following the end of the reporting period (i.e. reporting month).

The table below reports the percentage of POST in under 30 minutes, by calendar month for Queensland Health's reportable hospitals (Top 26) from October 2022 to December 2022.

The POST data for January 2023 will be released when the next round of quarterly data is published.
