## QUESTION:

With reference to Driver Training Accreditation fees and concerns that they are unnecessarily high as they were originally set to recover costs for services which are no longer incurred by TMR and which have been outsourced to Registered Training Organisations and paid for directly by Driver Trainers—

Will the Minister consider either reducing the annual accreditation charge, or hold the charge and extend the number of years that this accreditation covers?
