Question on Notice No. 651 Asked on 24 May 2023

MR R STEVENS ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide for the Moreton police district, the number of RBT tests undertaken and traffic infringement notices issued (reported separately by year) for the last five calendar years?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the number of RBTs conducted in Moreton District in 2018 is 158,319, 2019 is 151,652, 2020 is 78,921, 2021 is 52,821, 2022 is 83,715. I am advised by the QPS that the decrease in RBTs conducted in 2020 and 2021 is due to a statewide suspension on RBTs. This suspension was based on health advice received due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

I am also advised by the QPS that the number of traffic infringements issued in the Moreton District in 2018 is 14,321, 2019 is 20,115, 2020 is 21,092, 2021 is 18,057, 2022 is 22,631.
