MR T WATTS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

With reference to a press release on 18 August 2017 the then Attorney-General stated the Palaszczuk Government had 'Accepted all of the 83 recommendations of the Independent Review into Youth Detention in Queensland and invested \$26.2 million over four years to implement these recommendations'—

Will the Attorney-General advise (a) how many of these recommendations have been implemented and on what date, (b) how many are still yet to be implemented and (c) how many were not implemented?
