MR S O'CONNOR asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier provide the total allocated funding for approved projects under the Resource Recovery Industry Development Program (reported separately by the amount of funding spent (or committed) to each project)?

ANSWER:

Since 2018, 33 projects have been approved under the Resource Recovery Industry Development Program for a total funding allocation of \$52,361,144.

There have been 29 approved projects announced for a total funding allocation of \$34,074,712 as follows –
