MS S BOLTON ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the ongoing safety and congestion issues at the dangerous Diamond and Elm Street intersections and the Myall and Elm Street intersections in Cooroy—

Will the Minister provide details on when and how these will be remedied?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Noosa for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has initiated early planning for the upgrades of intersections at Diamond and Elm Street, and Myall and Elm Street, in Cooroy. The early indications from planning for the preferred option for both upgrades is the installation of traffic signals.

At present, no funding has been allocated for the progression of these intersection upgrades. An investment decision will be made following the outcomes of planning in future Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program reviews. The upgrades will need to compete with other priorities within the state-controlled road network for funding.
