MR B HEAD ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITIAL SERVICES (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to Restricted Access Vehicle (Heavy Vehicle) permits across Callide—

Will the Minister outline (a) all routes that currently hold active permits, (b) total number and class types of permit by route and (c) total number of currently outstanding applications?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Callide for the question.

The electoral district of Callide consists of six state-controlled main arterial roads: Leichhardt Highway, Burnett Highway, Dawson Highway, Eidsvold Theodore Road, Fitzroy Developmental Road and Baralaba Rannes Road. As listed below, all of these State controlled routes currently hold active permits.

Leichhardt Highway

Active permits: Class 1 – 1348, Class 2 – 29, Class 3 – 18 and Total – 1395.

Burnett Highway

Active permits: Class 1 - 607, Class 2 - 40, Class 3 - 15 and Total - 662.

Dawson Highway

Active permits: Class 1 – 1729, Class 2 – 144, Class 3 – 40 and Total – 1913.

Eidsvold Theodore Road

Active permits: Class 1 – 2, Class 2 – 20, Class 3 – 13 and Total – 35.

Fitzroy Developmental Road

Active permits: Class 1 – 2, Class 2 – 1, Class 3 – 1 and Total – 4.

Baralaba Rannes Road

Active permits: Class 1 – 7, Class 2 – 22, Class 3 – 18 and Total – 47.

There are 340 applications currently under assessment for state-controlled roads in the electoral district of Callide.
