Will the Minister advise how costs for this training has been determined given that the training program is yet to be developed?

ANSWER:

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is committed to ensuring the cost of any training and assessment is reasonable. To identify a suitable provider to develop and deliver Approved Inspection Station training and assessment, TMR undertook an open and competitive two-staged procurement process.
