MS R BATES ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister provide as at 1 June 2023, the following in relation to Queensland Health using hotel, motel or resort style accommodation for patient care (reported separately by Hospital and Health Service) (a) the total number of beds available to Queensland Health at these facilities and (b) the total number of patients receiving care in the facilities?

ANSWER

Southport Lower Acuity Accommodation service has up to 24 single rooms available for medically stable, lower acuity patients.

Since opening on 4 May 2023, 117 patients have been cared for at the Southport Lower Acuity Accommodation.

There are no other hotel, motel or resort style arrangements in place in Queensland at this time.
