

## Question on Notice

**Ms F SIMPSON** ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

**QUESTION:** Will the Attorney-General provide an update to answer to Question on Notice No. 1237 asked on 28 October 2022, and in particular, if any evidence of inappropriate storage or access of ECQ worker's personal data has been detected?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Maroochydore for her question.

The Electoral Commission of Queensland (ECQ) advises that response to Question on Notice 1237 asked on 28 October 2022 is still current. As part of the ECQ's ongoing assurance program, third party reviews of system logs and source code undertaken by independent experts have not found any evidence that any electoral data, including worker personal data, has been improperly accessed or stored.

All data is stored in secure environments located in Australia and under the ECQ's direct control.
