MRS D FRECKLINGTON asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund (RCIF)— Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) why the coal producing region of the South Burnett has never been included as an eligible community and (b) if the South Burnett will be considered for future rounds to acknowledge the importance of this resource community to the economy of Queensland?

ANSWER:

(a) The South Burnett local government area (LGA) was an eligible region under Rounds 1 and 2 of the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund.

(b) Any future rounds of the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund would be subject to government consideration.
