**MS A LEAHY** ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

## QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise of the cost estimates (reported separately by individual council) the Queensland Electoral Commission has provided to Local Governments in Queensland for the conduct of the 2024 Local Government Election?

### ANSWER:

I am advised that in April 2023, the Electoral Commissioner wrote to each of Queensland's 77 local government Chief Executive Officers and provided a cost estimate for conducting the 2024 elections.

The total cost of the 2024 local government elections is currently estimated to be approximately \$37.1 million. Of the total cost, local governments are estimated to cover approximately \$28.6 million, equating to a per-elector cost of approximately \$7.83. The ECQ will absorb the remainder as indirect costs, which includes advertising and engagement, call centres and compliance.

The ECQ has endeavoured to contain cost increases as much as practicable, however there are several factors driving the increase in costs, including:

- increased staff costs coupled with a tight labour market
- higher prices charged by key suppliers that provide critical services for election delivery such as postage, logistic and printing
- high demand for short-term office and venue leases thereby increasing costs for returning offices, early voting centres and polling booths, and
- significant state-wide growth in elector numbers.
