MR T MANDER ASKED THE MINISTER HOUSING (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Estimates Hearing of the Community Support Services Committee where the Director-General of Housing advised in relation to State Owned and Managed Indigenous Housing, ‘in terms of the RoGS data, a return for one of the larger Indigenous councils was not provided for that year and that is why there is a discrepancy here’—

Will the Minister provide (a) what financial year the Director-General was referring to and (b) the number of dwellings that were not provided that year?

ANSWER:

The RoGS data referred to by the Director-General as referenced in the Estimates hearing was Indigenous Community Housing (ICH), not State Owned and Managed Indigenous Housing (SOMIH).

ICH dwelling data and ICH household occupancy data are obtained through the annual National Community Housing Survey that is led by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare.
