MR N DAMETTO ASKED MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL BUSINESS, MINISTER FOR TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE (HON D FARMER)

QUESTION:

With reference to youth crime—

Will the Minister advise (a) how many juveniles, aged between 10 and 17, have been convicted of either murder, attempted murder or manslaughter in the past five years (reported separately by offence and age) and (b) of those juveniles convicted of the above offences, how many resided in residential care houses at the time of the offence?

ANSWER:

As part A of this matter falls under the responsibilities of the Department of Justice and Attorney-General. I refer the Member to the Honourable Yvette D'Ath MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence.

Part B falls under the responsibilities of the Department of Child Safety, Seniors and Disability Services. I refer the Member to the Honourable Craig Crawford MP, Minister for Child Safety and Minister for Seniors and Disability Services.
