MR N DAMETTO ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)

With reference to the Patient Transport Subsidy Scheme (PTSS) and concerns that the PTSS continues to fall short in providing equitable access to healthcare for patients across regional and remote Queensland despite the 2023 increase of \$10 per person per night for accommodation and 4 cents per kilometre for mileage—

Will the Minister commit to a comprehensive review of the PTSS to address these concerns and ensure that the subsidy rates are sufficient to meet the needs of patients in all regions of Queensland?
