MS J HOWARD ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the (a) rate and (b) total number of victims of sexual assault(s) between 1 January 2024 and the day of the change of government, (reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District, in a table)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the number and rate of reported victims of sexual offences from 1 January 2024 to 25 October 2024 is detailed in the table below:
