MS M SCANLON ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the (a) rate and (b) total number of victims, of homicide (murder) and all other homicide offences between 1 January 2024 and 28 October 2024, (reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District, in a table)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the number and rate of reported victims of homicide (murder) and other homicide offences from 1 July 2024 to 25 October 2024 is detailed in the table below:
