DR B O'SHEA ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) whether the Logan to Gold Coast Faster rail project will be delivered in full, on time and on budget and (b) if not, why not?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail (LGC) project aims to support the growing population and travel demand between Brisbane and the Gold Coast.

Under the former government, the LGC has blown out by more than \$3 billion from its originally budgeted cost. Therefore, it will not be possible to deliver LGC within its original project budget.

In contrast, the LNP has committed to deliver projects on time and on budget. I would urge the Member to keep up to date on this project by visiting
