MR D LEE ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister (a) provide an update on the status of infrastructure projects at the Hervey Bay Hospital, including the hospital expansion and car parking and (b) is the Minister aware of any cost blowouts or delays from what was announced by the previous government?

ANSWER

The former government announced a Hervey Bay Hospital Expansion cost blowout of \$40 million to \$94 million, with no additional beds added to the scope of the program.

The Crisafulli Government is committed to delivering the health services and infrastructure that Queenslanders need.

The Government has appointed an independent team, led by hospital infrastructure specialist Sam Sangster, to conduct an analysis of the cost blowouts within the Capital Expansion Program, which includes the Hervey Bay Hospital Expansion. The Government will provide further updates following this process.
