# **QUESTION**

Will the Minister advise in table format the number of vehicles currently held within the Queensland Ambulance Service fleet, reported separately by (a) ambulances and other vehicles, (b) ambulance general purpose, (c) patient transport vehicles, (d) operational support vehicles, (e) special operations vehicles, (f) administrative vehicles and (g) other vehicles?

### **ANSWER**

The Queensland Ambulance Service has a total of 1,642 ambulances and other vehicles across the State. This has been broken down as per the table below:

(c) patient transport vehicles	101
(d) operational support vehicles	264
(e) special operations vehicles	40
