### **QUESTION**

With reference to Page 2 of the Minister's Charter Letter—

Will the Minister advise if the government's policy of 'using real-time health data to drive resources and staff to where they are needed', will involve Queensland Health staff being instructed to work across multiple sites within the Hospital and Health Service?

### **ANSWER**

The Queensland Government is committed to delivering transparent and up-to-date information about what is happening in our hospitals as part of the Government's 100 Day Plan.

Real-time reporting will make the health system more transparent and accountable, helping healthcare practitioners and consumers make more informed decisions about their care.

This data will help drive resources and staff to where they are needed from a systems planning perspective, rather than day-to-day rostering.

There will be no change to the operational control of hospitals over rostering and staffing decisions.
