MR B MELLISH ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

With reference to Page 2 of the Minister's Charter Letter—

Will the Minister advise if the publication of real-time health data will display in real-time (a) the number of hospital beds available across all wards and departments at all Queensland Health Hospitals and (b) and all code yellow events?

ANSWER

Queensland Health currently publishes the number of available beds and bed alternatives, broken down by facility, on a quarterly cadence at www.performance.health.qld.gov.au.

In addition to publishing the number of available beds, Queensland Health also monitors each hospital's resources and capacity to meet patient demand in a timely manner. The tier capacity escalation system supports hospital operations and communications and assists in the management of local capacity issues. The number of tier 3 capacity escalations which occur each month is also reported via the performance website for applicable facilities.
