MR M FURNER ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

With reference to the new Queensland Cancer Centre—

Will the Minister advise as at Monday 28 October 2024 (a) expenditure to date, (b) updated project budget, (c) expected completion date, (d) the specific scope and (e) specific additional services being provided?

ANSWER

As at the 28 October 2024, the Queensland Cancer Centre was publicly announced at \$1.125 billion (including a \$375 million contribution by the Commonwealth Government), however several health infrastructure projects across Queensland have suffered from significant cost blowouts and project delays from what was announced by the previous government.

The Crisafulli Government is committed to delivering the health services and infrastructure that Queenslanders need.

The Government has appointed an independent team, led by hospital infrastructure specialist Sam Sangster, to conduct an analysis of the cost blowouts within the Capital Expansion Program, which includes the new Queensland Cancer Centre. The Government will provide further updates following this process.
