**MR M DE BRENNI** ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

### **QUESTION**

Will the Minister advise in table format, the number of incarcerated First Nations peoples presenting with (a) injuries, (b) chronic conditions and (c) mental health concerns?

### **ANSWER**

I am advised the health records of people in prison are currently paper based. Therefore, data is not easily retrievable and would be an unreasonable diversion of resources to provide at this time.

I am advised Queensland Health is implementing the Prisoner electronic Medical Record for people receiving care from prisoner health services, which is anticipated to be completed in 2025-26.
