### QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) how Hospital and Health Services will be held to account on wait times and (b) the number of patients waiting at Queensland Health Emergency Departments?

### ANSWER

(a) The Queensland Government is committed to delivering transparent and up-to-date information about what is happening in our hospitals as part of the Government's 100 Day Plan. Real-time reporting will make the health system more transparent and accountable, helping healthcare practitioners and consumers make more informed decisions about their care.
