QUESTION

Will the Minister advise which health services are currently operating at a downgraded level under the Clinical Services Capability Framework, including the reason why the service is currently downgraded (reported separately in a table by Hospital and Health Service)?

ANSWER

The Crisafulli Government will reinstate the maternity services at Biloela and Cooktown Hospitals which have been closed since 2022.
