MR J LANGBROEK ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TREATY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS, MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Action Plan 2022–24 for Local Thriving Communities—Will the Minister provide an update on the outcomes to date for each of the five priority areas?

ANSWER:

The *Local Thriving Communities Action Plan 2022–2024* (the Action Plan) released by the Queensland Government, was developed through co-design with community representatives and leaders to progress the government reform required to enable Local Decision-Making Bodies (LDMBs).

A key outcome of the plan to date is the establishment of interim Local Decision-Making Bodies in ten remote and discrete communities and 17 urban and regional locations.

A comprehensive review of the outcomes for each of the five priority areas of the Action Plan will be considered in late 2024.
