MR P RUSSO ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise where long stay patients are reallocated to?

ANSWER

The relocation of long-stay patients is determined on a case-by-case basis. However, in general terms, long-stay patients typically return to their usual place of residence, move to new permanent or interim accommodation arrangements, or enter into residential aged care or disability care facilities.
