MR J KRAUSE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON B MELLISH)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister list the number of departmental employees as of September 2023 (reported separately by Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations code) and for each provide (a) the occupation code description and (b) whether it is a frontline, frontline support or corporate service role?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Scenic Rim for the question.

The Miles Government is delivering its eighth record transport and roads infrastructure program in a row, as detailed in the Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2023–24 to 2026–27, which outlines \$32.1 billion in investment over the next four years and is estimated to support an average of 25,200 direct jobs over the life of the program.

The Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations (ANZSCO) provides a basis for the standardised collection, analysis and dissemination of occupation data for Australia and New Zealand. This classification structure can be found on the Australian Bureau of Statistics website (https://www.abs.gov.au/statistics/classifications/anzsco-australian-and-new-zealand-standard-classification-occupations/latest-release), which provides descriptions for each ANZSCO code.

Frontline (including key frontline) and frontline support roles deliver services, programs and outcomes directly to the community, or provide essential support enabling the development and delivery of frontline services, programs and outcomes. Corporate roles provide organisation-wide support to the sector so that it can deliver the Queensland Government's objectives for the community.

A full list of information relating to the ANZSCO codes for each position and whether it is frontline and frontline support or corporate services within the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is provided in the following table. For the Member's reference, the Queensland Government Customer and Digital Group was transferred to TMR as indicated in the Public Service Departmental Arrangements Notice (No.2) 2023 - published in the Government Gazette on 18 May 2023.
