I can confirm that further consultation is planned during April 2024 to update members on the remaining recommendations from the Queensland Family and Child Commission (QFCC) report, *Keeping Queensland's children more than safe: review of the blue card system* (QFCC Blue Card Review Report).

This consultation occurs in conjunction with the additional external stakeholder group, the Implementation Oversight Group, established in part in response to the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee Report No. 38, and the Safe Children and Strong Communities strategy and action plan (QFCC Blue Card Review Report recommendation 73). The Implementation Oversight Group met five times during 2022 and three times during 2023.
