Question on Notice No. 140 Asked on 5 March 2024

$\ensuremath{\mathsf{MR}}$ T watts asked minister for police and community safety (hon m Ryan)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise in the last 12 months (reported per 28-day roster period) for the Toowoomba General Duties roster, how many overtime hours were worked and for what purpose i.e. continuation of rostered duty, operations, due to sick leave?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that between 1 March 2023 and 29 February 2024, police officers attached to Toowoomba Division collectively worked a total of 11,324.50 overtime hours (this figure is inclusive of special duty undertaken by officers attached to Toowoomba Police Division).

I am further advised by the QPS that to provide a more detailed breakdown of overtime hours would require a manual examination of records and is considered to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
