MS R BATES ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

QUESTION

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 1204 of 2021— Will the Minister provide, for each of the 106 reporting hospitals listed on the 'Hospital Performance' website, the total number of beds (a) available in December 2023 and (b) unavailable in December 2023?

ANSWER

The Miles Government is committed to delivering the health services and infrastructure that Queenslanders need. We have delivered more than 1,500 beds since 2015 and have a plan to deliver almost 3,500 more beds in Queensland hospitals through the Health Big Build.

Due to the complexity of delivering healthcare, available bed numbers across Queensland public hospitals are a dynamic measure and may fluctuate according to relative demand across the system.

Hospitals manage their daily bed or bed alternative availability according to local service needs. As such, this number is not static and forms part of the complex management of health care service delivery.

Across the 106 reporting hospitals, the total number of available and unavailable beds in December 2023 was 13,443.

Of these, the total number of temporarily unavailable beds across the 106 reporting hospitals was 109 beds, or approximately 0.81% of all beds.

Reasons that beds may be temporarily unavailable include renovations or other capital works. For example, renovations lead to some beds being temporarily unavailable in December 2023 at Cairns, Charleville, Cunnamulla, Mornington Island, and St George.

Furthermore, 17 beds were temporarily unavailable at Thursday Island Hospital while work is completed on the hospital redevelopment, which is due to finish in the coming months.
