MR M BERKMAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND COMMUNITY SAFETY (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the deployment of the Counter-Terrorism Investigation Group (CTIG) in response to political protests— Will the Minister advise (a) if the Queensland Police Service has a formal identification mechanism for political groups, analogous to the NSW Police 'Issue Motivated Group' identification and (b) what management and response techniques are used by the Queensland Police Service to manage and contain the potential for disruption from protests, and what operational document are these recorded in?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the QPS analyses information relating to any protest to minimise disruption and/or danger to members of the community. In the interests of protecting Queensland's security and intelligence environment, I am unable to provide any additional information about police methodologies.
