QUESTION

With reference to staffing levels at Kingaroy Hospital (FTEs, part-time, casual and contract staff)—

Will the Minister advise (a) staffing levels for each year from 2019 until current and (b) how many shifts were short-staffed in 2023?

ANSWER

I am pleased to advise that in 2023, staffing levels at the Kingaroy Hospital increased by approximately 6.8%, thanks to the hard work of the Darling Downs HHS. The staffing levels at Kingaroy Hospital for each year from 2019 until current are presented below:

In relation to the query about staffing of shifts, I am advised by the Darling Downs HHS that hospital resources are actively managed according to clinical workload. The Clinical team leaders are required to manage their utilisation with a degree of flexibility to appropriately account for:

- Patient and staff safety;
- Volume and acuity of patients;
- Hospital / ward layout; and
- External environmental factors.
