DR C ROWAN ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE (HON D FARMER)

QUESTION:

With reference to the A – E educational outcomes in English and Mathematics—

Will the Minister detail the proportion of students achieving each educational outcome (reported separately by year level and by school year) from Year Prep to Year 9, and for the school years 2020 to 2023?

ANSWER:

English

Prep Year – 2020: A 19.7%, B 29.1%, C 29.9%, D 16.9% and E 4.4%; 2021: A 21.8%, B 31.1%, C 29.6%, D 14.3% and E 3.2%; 2022: 23.6%, B 31.1%, C 28.8%, D 13.3% and E 3.2%; and 2023: A 27.4%, B 32.8%, C 26.1%, D 11.1% and E 2.6%.

Year 1 – 2020: A 12.3%, B 29.9%, C 35.2%, D 18.0% and E 4.7%; 2021: A 14.2%, B 30.6%, C 34.2%, D 17.0% and E 3.9%; 2022: A 16.6%, B 31.6%, C 32.4%, D 15.7% and E 3.7%; and 2023: A 19.3%, B 32.6%, C 31.2%, D 13.8% and E 3.1%.

Year 2 – 2020: A 12.3%, B 30.3%, C 37.6%, D 16.5% and E 3.4%; 2021: A 13.7%, B 31.8%, C 36.1%, D 15.3% and E 3.1%; 2022: A 15.7%, B 32.1%, C 34.8%, D 14.5% and E 2.9%; and 2023: A 17.5%, B 33.2%, C 33.4%, D 13.1% and E 2.8%.

Year 3 – 2020: A 11.0%, B 29.4%, C 41.5%, D 15.9% and E 2.2%; 2021: A 12.2%, B 30.7%, C 40.2%, D 14.8% and E 2.0%; 2022: A 13.4%, B 31.8%, C 39.0%, D 13.8% and E 2.0%; and 2023: A 14.9%, B 32.5%, C 37.8%, D 13.0% and E 1.8%.

Year 4 – 2020: A 11.5%, B 29.1%, C 42.4%, D 15.4% and E 1.6%; 2021: A 12.4%, B 30.4%, C 41.4%, D 14.4% and E 1.4%; 2022: A 14.1%, B 31.3%, C 39.9%, D 13.3% and E 1.4%; and 2023: A 15.7%, B 32.3%, C 38.6%, D 12.1% and E 1.4%.

Year 5 – 2020: A 11.9%, B 28.5%, C 42.7%, D 15.5% and E 1.5%; 2021: A 12.9%, B 29.0%, C 42.3%, D 14.5% and E 1.3%; 2022: A 14.0%, B 30.0%, C 41.3%, D 13.5% and E 1.3%; and 2023: A 15.3%, B 30.8%, C 40.4%, D 12.3% and E 1.2%.

Year 6 – 2020: A 14.6%, B 29.9%, C 41.5%, D 12.9% and E 1.1%; 2021: A 15.7%, B 30.6%, C 40.4%, D 12.2% and E 1.1%; 2022: A 17.1%, B 31.4%, C 39.5%, D 11.0% and E 1.0%; and 2023: A 18.4%, B 31.9%, C 38.4%, D 10.3% and E 1.0%.

Year 7 – 2020: A 12.1%, B 30.9%, C 43.8%, D 11.7% and E 1.6%; 2021: A 12.5%, B 31.8%, C 42.1%, D 11.8% and E 1.8%; 2022: A 14.3%, B 32.7%, C 40.4%, D 10.8% and E 1.8%; and 2023: A 15.9%, B 33.2%, C 38.8%, D 10.4% and E 1.7%.

Year 8 – 2020: A 11.7%, B 30.9%, C 42.6%, D 12.6% and E 2.1%; 2021: A 12.9%, B 31.2%, C 41.2%, D 12.3% and E 2.3%; 2022: A 14.2%, B 31.2%, C 40.5%, D 11.8% and E 2.4%; and 2023: A 15.9%, B 32.9%, C 38.2%, D 10.6% and E 2.3%.

Year 9 – 2020: A 12.2%, B 30.7%, C 41.5%, D 13.0% and E 2.5%; 2021: A 12.9%, B 31.1%, C 40.1%, D 13.1% and E 2.9%; 2022: A 14.6%, B 31.4%, C 38.6%, D 12.4% and E 3.0%; and 2023: A 16.3%, B 31.3%, C 37.8%, D 11.4% and E 3.2%.

Mathematics

Prep Year – 2020: A 26.8%, B 35.0%, C 26.2%, D 9.7% and E 2.3%; 2021: A 28.8%, B 36.0%, C 25.0%, D 8.4% and E 1.9%; 2022: A 31.2%, B 35.5%, C 23.7%, D 7.8% and E 1.8%; and 2023: A 35.1%, B 35.7%, C 20.9%, D 6.8% and E 1.6%.

Year 1 – 2020: A 18.5%, B 37.3%, C 30.5%, D 11.3% and E 2.5%; 2021: A 21.3%, B 38.1%, C 28.2%, D 10.3% and E 2.1%; 2022: A 24.3%, B 38.3%, C 26.1%, D 9.3% and E 2.0%; and 2023: A 28.1%, B 38.3%, C 23.8%, D 8.1% and E 1.7%.

Year 2 – 2020: A 15.6%, B 35.9%, C 33.6%, D 12.6% and E 2.3%; 2021: A 17.5%, B 37.3%, C 31.4%, D 11.6% and E 2.3%; 2022: A 20.1%, B 37.6%, C 29.4%, D 10.9% and E 2.0%; and 2023: A 22.3%, B 39.1%, C 27.7%, D 9.1% and E 1.8%.

Year 3 – 2020: A 15.9%, B 34.5%, C 35.1%, D 12.6% and E 1.8%; 2021: A 18.0%, B 35.8%, C 33.3%, D 11.3% and E 1.6%; 2022: A 20.0%, B 36.5%, C 31.5%, D 10.5% and E 1.5%; and 2023: A 22.1%, B 37.7%, C 29.3%, D 9.4% and E 1.5%.

Year 4 – 2020: A 17.2%, B 32.9%, C 35.8%, D 12.7% and E 1.4%; 2021: A 18.8%, B 34.1%, C 34.3%, D 11.6% and E 1.2%; 2022: A 20.4%, B 35.0%, C 32.8%, D 10.6% and E 1.2%; and 2023: A 22.9%, B 35.5%, C 30.8%, D 9.7% and E 1.2%.

Year 5 – 2020: A 17.1%, B 32.9%, C 36.1%, D 12.7% and E 1.2%; 2021: A 18.1%, B 33.8%, C 35.0%, D 12.0% and E 1.1%; 2022: A 20.3%, B 33.8%, C 33.6%, D 11.1% and E 1.1%; and 2023: A 22.0%, B 35.3%, C 32.1%, D 9.5% and E 1.0%.

Year 6 – 2020: A 19.3%, B 32.3%, C 35.4%, D 11.9% and E 1.2%; 2021: A 20.5%, B 33.5%, C 33.6%, D 11.3% and E 1.2%; 2022: A 22.5%, B 33.5%, C 32.5%, D 10.4% and E 1.1%; and 2023: A 24.7%, B 33.8%, C 31.1%, D 9.3% and E 1.1%.

Year 7 – 2020: A 18.0%, B 29.5%, C 35.4%, D 14.5% and E 2.7%; 2021: A 18.4%, B 30.3%, C 34.5%, D 14.0% and E 2.8%; 2022: A 19.8%, B 31.1%, C 34.2%, D 12.6% and E 2.3%; and 2023: A 20.4%, B 32.1%, C 33.6%, D 11.7% and E 2.1%.

Year 8 – 2020: A 15.7%, B 26.0%, C 36.4%, D 17.6% and E 4.2%; 2021: A 15.8%, B 27.9%, C 36.1%, D 16.1% and E 4.1%; 2022: A 17.0%, B 28.7%, C 35.5%, D 15.4% and E 3.6%; and 2023: A 18.7%, B 30.0%, C 34.5%, D 13.8% and E 3.1%.

Year 9 – 2020: A 16.5%, B 26.1%, C 34.0%, D 17.9% and E 5.5%; 2021: A 16.5%, B 26.3%, C 33.6%, D 17.7% and E 5.9%; 2022: A 17.0%, B 26.9%, C 33.9%, D 16.7% and E 5.5%; and 2023: A 19.6%, B 27.3%, C 33.2%, D 15.1% and E 4.8%.

Results exclude students assessed at a different age cohort from their peers (including students assessed against an Individual Curriculum Plan) or for whom insufficient evidence is available to make a judgement (N results).

Students may be represented more than once per Learning Area and reporting period, as they may have received results in multiple subjects.
